



Safety Instructions

The San Diego Junior Golf Foundation safety instructions are designed to make golf fun, and provide a safe learning environment for all members.

1. No running on the golf course at any time.
2. No loud talking on the golf course at any time.
3. Listen to instructors at all times.
4. No horse playing allowed.
5. All members must display good behavior at all times.
6. Never leave the group practice area.
7. Do not stand in front of another player while they are hitting the ball.
8. Always follow the rules of golf.
9. Ask permission to be dismissed.
10. Always keep track of your golf clubs.
11. Practice golf etiquette (rules).
12. Respect the rights of others to learn.
13. No talking or giggling while the instructor is teaching.
14. Be kind to yourself and others.
15. Focus on learning and be prepared to learn.
16. No socializing during practice hours.
17. Behave safely and have regard for the safety of others.
18. Wear appropriate clothing to the golf course.
19. Do not bring valuables to the golf course.
20. Advise the instructor if you are taking any medication.
21. Do not leave the Jr. golf office after returning from practice - wait until your parents arrive.
22. Never strike another member with your hand or any item.
23. Always have fun with any sport.
24. On field trips, always wear your name tag.
25. Always practice and demonstrate these safety rules.
